Improve collaboration between schools and parents' associations to form ethical role models for children.

Given the new social and economic reality, today, entrepreneurship is a matter of urgency and contributes, among others, to prevent unemployment and social exclusion of young people. Moreover, based on European Commission, entrepreneurial competences are increasingly important in business, whether in the public or the not-for-profit sectors, together with resilience and empathy, creativity, and critical thinking. Since 2006, European Commission has been helping education reforms with various programmes such as “Erasmus+” which promotes partnerships, or “Young Entrepreneurs” which has been designed to develop entrepreneurial skills through practice by creating junior companies in a European context. The kit outlines a project ideally organized with teachers at schools across Europe. Each school has been challenged to create a ‘real ‘company with elected officers and roles for each pupil. During this program, pupils have been experiencing situations for the use of ICT and foreign languages as tools in a multicultural environment.

ETHICSBOARD project addresses identified challenges and opportunities. This project will enable students to develop and promote entrepreneurship education, entrepreneurial skills and Portfolios, ensure the benefits of an early childhood education, help develop critical and innovative thinking, and above all improve collaboration between schools and parents' association.

ETHICSBOARD has officially started on 1st October 2017 and will end on 30th September 2019. During this period, it will aim to act in education, to develop and disseminate creativity to convert it into innovation by organising. To achieve these aims, all participating schools will work to generate skills to contribute to future changes in our society.
